Your HealthChoice Illinois Plan Choices

All plans have the same **basic** Medicaid services you get now, such as:

- 24/7 nurse line
- Behavioral health services
- Doctor services
- Eye care services
- Hearing services
- Home health care
- Hospice care

- Hospital services
- Lab tests and x-rays
- Medical supplies
- Prescriptions
- Therapy
- Transportation to medically necessary appointments

All plans have extra benefits, such as **Care Coordinators** who will help you find the providers and services you need. Use these charts to compare the **extra** benefits and services each health plan offers.

Important: If you receive Medicare benefits, Medicare will cover most of the services listed above. Your HealthChoice Illinois plan (Medicaid) will only cover:

- Your long term care services if you live in a nursing home or supportive living facility
- Your home and community based waiver services (such as the Aging or Physically Disabled waivers)
- Non-emergency transportation and some behavioral health services

Not all extra benefits will apply to you if you receive Medicare benefits. **Extra benefits marked** with a star (②) are available to enrollees with Medicare benefits.

Pregnancy and healthy kids

- You may qualify for:
 - Up to \$75 on a rewards card by completing a Notification of Pregnancy form and one postpartum appointment
 - A free car seat by completing a Notification of Pregnancy form, one prenatal appointment and one postpartum appointment
 - Up to \$80 by completing well child appointments in the first 30 months of life
 - \$10 each year by completing yearly well child visits for members ages 3 to 21

Transportation

- You can get a ride to a pharmacy right after your doctor visit and to a medical equipment provider
- New mothers can get a ride to Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) food assistance sites for 30 days after their baby's birth

Vision

 You can get \$100 toward a pair of eyeglass frames, choose a free pair of eyeglass frames from the MARCH frame kit, or get \$80 toward contact lenses every two years

- You may qualify for:
 - A rewards card when you complete certain preventive services, such as yearly health screenings
 - A free gym membership at participating locations
 - A free weight management membership
 - A free cell phone to call your doctor, care coordinator, 9-1-1 emergency services or Lifeline cell services
- Members with diabetes or heart disease can get in-home test kits
- You can get help to stop smoking
